Transportation / arrival to the Helsinki airport

- Helsinki Airport locates 20 kilometres from Helsinki City Centre.
- Transportation from the Helsinki airport to the Helsinki South Harbor, Olympia Terminal.
 - You can choose to travel by train, taxi, public transport or foot. We recommend traveling by train to the Helsinki Central railway station and from there to walk or take a bus or a tram.



Taxi

- If you are leaving the airport by taxi, you will find the taxi station outside the Arrivals hall. There are four taxi lanes, and you can choose which lane and which taxi company you want to use.
- The three taxi companies that have an agreement with the airport company Finavia operate from lane 1-3. These are FixuTaxi, Taksi Helsinki and Menevä-taksi. The fares for those taxis are indicated on the taxi station. Other taxi companies operate from lane 4.



Public transport (train)

- Helsinki Airport's train station is located under the terminal. There is a direct elevator and escalator connection from the departures and arrivals hall to the train station.
 - Local I and P trains operate to and from Helsinki Airport. A train ride to Helsinki City Centre takes about 30 minutes. Local train tickets can be purchased from HSL's mobile app, or from the ticket machine at the train platform. Timetables, tickets and fares for local trains and can be found on [HSL website](#).



Public transport (bus)

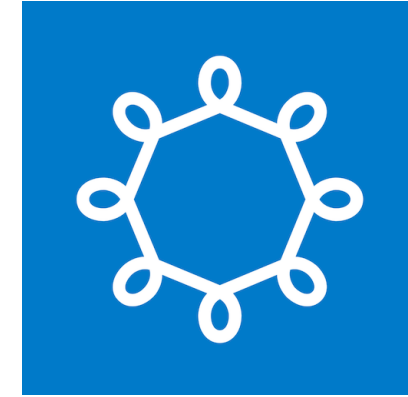
- Helsinki Airport's bus station is located outside the Arrivals hall.
 - Bus route 600 operates between Helsinki Airport and Helsinki City Centre. The travel time is about 40 minutes. Tickets can be purchased online on HSL's mobile app, or at the bus station's ticket machine. Read more about tickets and fares from [HSL website](#).



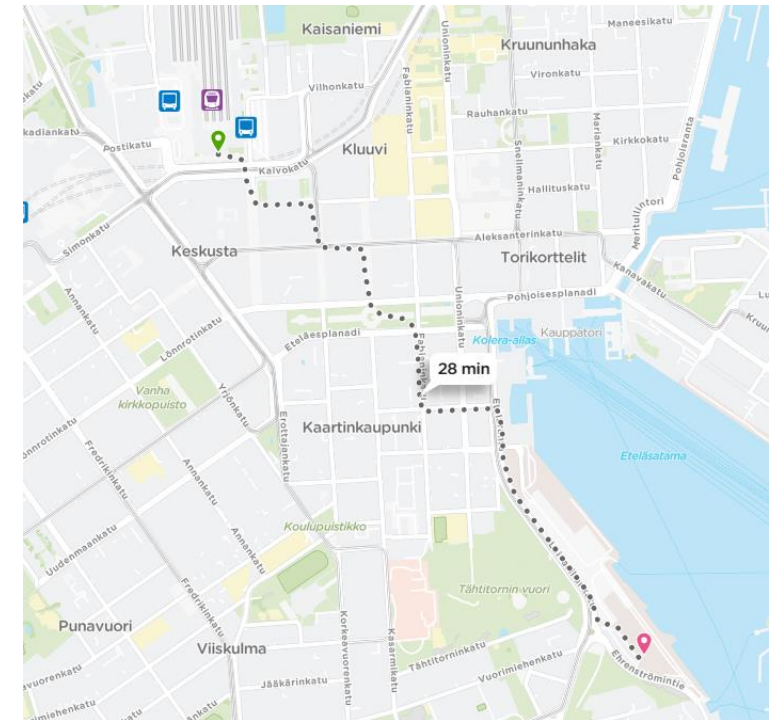
Public transport (tram)

- Tram 2 goes to Olympia terminal from the railway station (2,2 km) and from Kamppi bus terminal (tram stop on Mannerheimintie) (3,1 km).
- Tram 3 goes to Olympia terminal from the railway station via Kaivopuisto park.

Walk from the Helsinki Central railway station and the HSL app



- You can also walk to the Olympia terminal from the Helsinki Central railway station. It takes about 30 minutes.
- All the given routes can be found on the HSL app. Download the HSL app for free from your app store.
 - Open [AppStore](#) or [GooglePlay](#) on your phone and search for HSL. You can recognize the app by the blue HSL logo. With the HSL app, you can buy single, day, multi-journey, season and zone extension tickets.
 - Select the "Tickets" tab and follow the instructions. You can pay your tickets by a debit or credit card that you have linked to the app. You can pay by VISA, VISA Electron, Mastercard and Amex. You can choose either debit or credit.
 - Buy your ticket in good time and ensure that the ticket has arrived on your phone, and you are able to show it if asked to. The ticket must be on your phone before you board a bus, train or tram.
